Endowment 150 offers eligible people with disabilities a one-time grant of \$150 to help their Registered Disability Savings Plan (RDSP) grow. This \$150 grant, plus grants and bonds available from the Federal Government, will help you save for your future or that of a loved one.

Who can apply?

The Endowment 150 grant is available to the following BC residents:

- Adults with a disability, who are under 60 (if 59, the individual must apply before the end of the calendar year in which they turn 59) years of age, have an RDSP, and have received income assistance sometime after January 1st, 2008 or have had net income below \$37,487 in one year since 2008.
- Children with a disability, who are 17 years old or younger, and have an RDSP.
